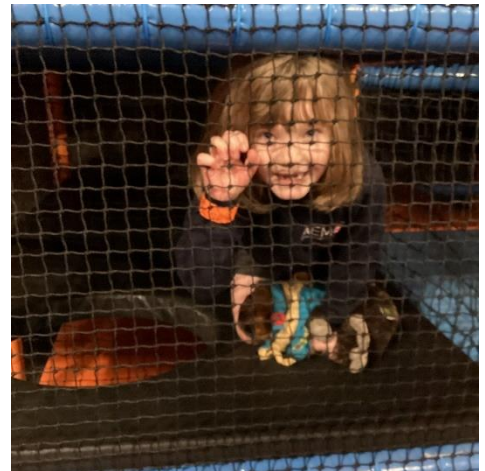
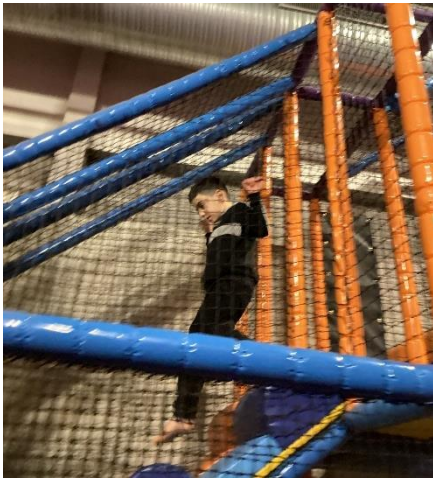
### Pronto Rugby

One way to relax and unwind is to have a massage. This was true for our students, who enjoyed a hand massage with scented lotion.



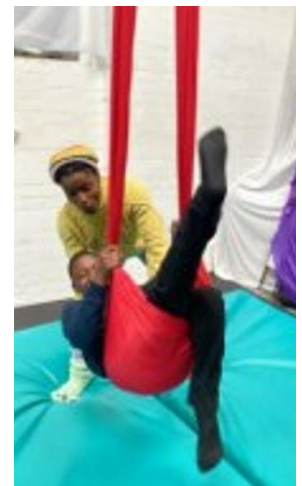
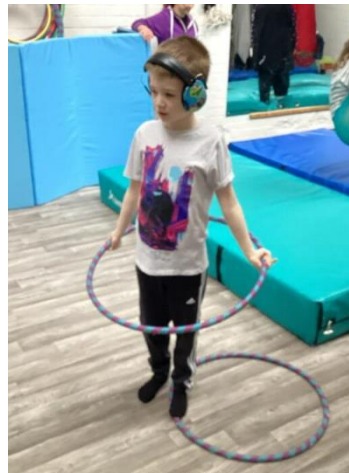
## National Justice Museum

A great day was spent learning about the countries justice system. Students enjoyed immersing themselves into a court experience, playing the different roles of a court scene.



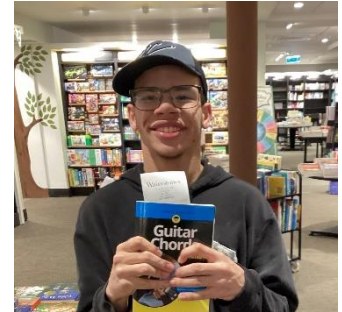
## Circus Hub
